

## Short CV prof. Concetta Maria Pontecorvo

Concetta Maria Pontecorvo is Full Professor of International Law at the Department of Economics, Management and Institutions (DEMI) of the Federico II University of Naples (UNINA) since 25 January 2021 (pending the updating of the MIUR CINECA database on the staff of university professors). Formerly Associate Professor of International Law (from 2002 to 24.1.2021) and Researcher of International Law (from March to November 2002) at UNINA.

As to her (post lauream) scientific education, Prof. Pontecorvo got the *Master Programme in International Law* at the Free University of Brussels (ULB) (1993) and the *PhD in International Economic Law*, at the Bocconi University of Milan (1997). She was *Internal Research Fellow* and *External Research Associate* at the Max Planck Institute für Völkerrecht of Heidelberg, Germany (1997-1999); she was also *Assegnista di ricerca* at the Department of Law and Economics of the Federico II University of Naples (2000-2001).

Prof. Pontecorvo has extensively published (4 monographs, 2 edited books, over 40 articles in journals and many chapters in volumes) in various fields of the fields of international and EU law (besides on international health law, on international economic and trade law, international environmental law, international counter-terrorism law, UN Law, international law of armed conflicts and EU natural resources law) with outstanding publishers including Brill, Springer, Kluwer, Giuffré, Cedam and Giappichelli and in top-ranked legal journals (ANVUR "Class A" ranking).

She was invited speaker in more than 80 international conferences in Italy, Germany, The Netherlands, Belgium, Switzerland, France and Spain, and she was also chairman at many of them.

She is a member of the Editorial Committee of the review *Ordine internazionale e diritti umani* (OIDU, "Class A" ranked, [www.rivistaoidu.net](http://www.rivistaoidu.net)) and of that of the review *Rassegna di diritto pubblico europeo* (until 2015). She regularly serves as referee for many (Italian and foreign) "class A" ranked journals.
